Scholarship *Recipient* Instructions

*All scholarship funds will be paid directly to the institution on behalf of the student by the Sweetwater Woman's Club after official verification of enrollment has been received. It is the recipient's responsibility to complete this process in a timely manner so that funds can be received by the institution on schedule.

In order to claim your scholarship, we **must** have this information:

- 1. Your student ID number at the school receiving your scholarship. Without this information the school won't know which account to deposit the scholarship check.
- 2. Copy of official verification of enrollment as a full-time student (12 units or more).
- 3. The address of the school and name of the office on campus where the check needs to go. Without this information your scholarship check will not reach its intended destination.
- 4. Who the school would like the check payable to and what other information should be included on the check.
